Parents, your financial contributions have made this all possible. Let me tell you why your continuing support is so vital.

Palos Verdes High School is entering its 9th year since the reopening of the school in 2002. We have received "Top 100 Public Schools in the Nation" recognition from U.S. News and World Report in the past and in June we heard that PVHS was ranked by Newsweek as #239 in the nation. Most importantly we see our seniors going off to great public and private universities every year. I feel that we have created an academic environment where students can reach their full potential as they move to the college and university level.

Our one Booster Club has three committees which support "Academics," "Arts" and "Athletics." We have been raising over \$400,000 a year to supplement district funding. In the academic arena these funds have been critical in supporting our library, college career center and the respective departments. We are able to offer before and after school tutoring in math and English, teachers are able to attend conferences to stay current in their fields, and we annually are able to purchase the technology and other equipment that is so vital to an academic program.

Our offerings in the area of arts are outstanding. Students who have a passion for drama, dance, singing or the visual arts have great opportunities. We are lucky to have outstanding teachers and the Booster Club funding has allowed us to purchase the equipment and put on the performances to showcase our students. The same can be said for athletics. PVHS has one of the most respected athletic programs in the South Bay and beyond. The Booster Club has supported the facility enhancements with the weight room, training room, gym, stadium field, pool, tennis courts, baseball field and softball facility. Our athletes are well coached, they have great uniforms, they are having a very positive high school athletic experience, and our elite athletes are moving on to compete at the college and university level. The arts and the athletic programs are allowing our students to have a very well rounded high school experience. Most importantly, many of our top scholars are involved in these programs.

I don't have to tell you that this coming year will be a challenge. The funding for public schools in California is at a critical stage. It is our goal to provide everything we have in the past for our students. We want them to have a great high school experience. We are hoping that "a participation donation" for all the athletic and non-athletic extra curricular programs will help to make up the shortfall. I encourage you to continue to support our Booster Club because it is such an important part of our school. The "Kickoff Party" and the "Catch The Wave" event are great social events as well. Parents, we want you to enjoy these high school years along with your kids. Welcome to the 2010-2011 school year. It is going to be another great one!

Booster Club FAQs

What is Booster Club?

Booster Club is the fundraising arm of Palos Verdes High School. The mission of PVHS Booster Club is to supplement limited public school funding. At Palos Verdes High School, we have one booster club that supports arts, academics and athletics. Since its inception in 2001, PVHS Booster Club has raised over \$3,500,000. These funds go directly to Palos Verdes High School.

What is the advantage of having only one booster club?

The PVHS one booster club approach is unique and has several advantages. Within our booster club, we have academic, arts and athletic committees. This ensures that all programs, students, and staff are supported. Many schools have separate booster clubs for athletics, drama, music, dance and other extra curricular groups. Having one booster club gives PVHS the advantage of also supporting academic programs. Since academics are a priority for all PVHS students, it is only right that one third of funds raised support academics. The academic committee of the PVHS Booster Club supports the various departments, the library, the College and Career Center, computer room and counseling office. Having one booster club also helps parents stay informed and involved in all areas of the school. Since all students benefit from Booster Club funds, all families are invited to become Booster Club members.

How do I become a member?

How does Booster Club raise money?

Booster Club raises money in three ways: 1. The Annual Membership Drive 2. Catch the Wave event in March and 3. Escrip. For more information about membership, Catch the Wave and Escrip check our website at www.pvboosterclub.com

Are donations to PVHS Booster Club tax deductible?

Yes. Booster Club was established in 2001 as a 501c3 nonprofit tax-exempt organization and all donations are tax deductible. The tax ID number is 30-0005919.

How can I become involved in Booster Club?

Booster Club meetings are held on the second Tuesday of each month (except August) at 7pm in the PVHS library. The arts and athletic committees hold their meetings at 6pm on the same day and the academic committee meets separately on the 1st Tuesday of the month. These meetings are open to everyone and we hope you will attend! Booster Club holds two parties each year and we hope that you will attend or volunteer. Our Kick Off Party takes place in September after the first home football game and is at the home of a PVHS family. It is free to all Booster Club members. Catch the Wave is our annual fundraising event and will take place this year @ Trump National in RPV. It is always a fun evening and includes silent and live auctions, dinner and dancing. Check our website for information on attending or volunteering at these events.



Who are these people and why do they want my money???

ASB – Associated Student Body - \$70

This program is managed by Patty Camp and the elected student leadership of ASB working out of the Student Store, located across from the Cafeteria. The \$70 ASB card helps fund student activities including all Athletic teams, Song & Cheer teams, Dance competition, Jazz Band, Orchestra, Choir, Video Production/Live From 205, Drama & all Campus Clubs. Athletic teams, school clubs and all curricular and co-curricular programs have an ASB account controlled by the coach or advisor to hold funds collected for supplies, ticket sales, individual team/program fundraisers etc. Additionally, your ASB donation funds all school activities including dances, formals, Homecoming and Pep Rallies & Spirit Week as well as all athletic officiating, security personnel, timers and scorers in all sports at all levels (Frosh, JV&Varsity).

BOOSTER CLUB - \$200-\$5,000+

PVHS' fundraising organization - supplements limited state funding and meets ongoing costs for academic, arts and athletic programs. Provides funding for teacher and counselor training, classroom and library books, electronic databases, College and Career Center supplies and expenses, stipends for coaches and advisors including Live from 205, Marching Band, Jazz Band, Orchestra, the Fall and Spring Drama Productions, and all academic clubs including MUN, Mock Trial etc. The PVHS Booster Club is a 501c3 non-profit organization and all donations are tax deductible. Funds are raised through an Annual Membership Drive, the annual spring Catch the Wave Event and EScrip.

PEF – Peninsula Education Foundation \$1-\$25,000+

District-wide fundraising organization which supports all schools in the PVPUSD
501c3 non-profit organization – all donations are tax deductible. Funds Elementary Music, World Languages, Library & Tech Aides, Intermediate Safe School Counselors, High School Counselors, High School College & Career Centers, Advanced Engineering Programs PVIT & SMERT, Teachers & Smaller Classes.

PTSA – Parent Teacher Student Association - \$150

PVHS PTSA promotes the welfare of youth at home, in school and within the community. Some of the PTSA supported programs include Disaster Preparedness, Parents on Campus, Reflections, Red Ribbon Week, Capitol Convoy, Sacramento Safari, The Wave-monthly PVHS newsletter, the Senior Project, Parent Education, Student Volunteer Fair & College Fair. Programs are funded by parent donations. PTSA provides much of the volunteer power for many PVHS events.

~New~Participation Donation for Athletic & Extra-Curricular Programs \$150-\$575

This donation request has been implemented for school year 2010-2011 to offset a budget decrease totaling \$600,000 at both High Schools for their Athletic & Extra-Curricular programs. These donation dollars will be paid directly to the district to cover the cost of transportation, coaching stipends (in season), safety equipment and tournament fees. Additionally this donation will be asked of students participating in Cheer, Song, Marching Band/Drumline/Color Guard, Competition Dance, MUN, Choreo, Math Club, Drama, Newspaper, Academic Decathlon, and Vocal Music to cover the cost of Advisor Stipends, transportation and miscellaneous expenses. Uniform Donation \$15-\$40

Helps defray cost of varsity uniform replacement & cleaning for Marching Band and all athletic programs at PVHS. This collective fund allows the purchase and upkeep of all varsity uniforms which normally last 2-3 seasons at most.

PALOS VERDES HIGH SCHOOL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

1. Forms for STUDENT INSURANCE are available in the Athletic Office or Student Store.
2. ELIGIBILITY:
All athletes must pass four classes to satisfy C.I.F. eligibility requirements. "The C.I.F. Rule" has no probationary period. In addition all athletes and students involved in extra curricular activities must maintain a minimum 2.0 grade point average and have no more than one unsatisfactory citizenship mark. There is a one quarter probationary period the first time under a 2.0, or receiving two "U's." Two consecutive deficient report cards result in the student being declared ineligible.
3. PARTICIPATION DONATION:
In order to avoid cuts in our athletic and extra curricular programs, we are asking that parents pay a participation donation. These funds will help offset a district shortfall and allow us to continue to offer quality programs. The suggested donation reflects the cost of paying for coaches, transportation and miscellaneous other expenses for each program:
