ASB – Associated Student Body

ASB is managed in the Student Store along with the elected student leadership of ASB. The ASB card helps fund student activities including homecoming, dances, speakers, and music at lunch AND provides discounted entry for most school events. Athletic teams and school clubs have ASB accounts that are used to collect funds in support of their activities or program. Funds raised from ASB card sales help offset the annual costs for athletic game officials as well as athletic tournament entry fees and game/event security and attendants.

PARTICIPATION DONATION

The Participation Donation was originated in 2009 as a result of state budget cuts that threatened to eliminate the lower level sports and many extra-curricular activities at both Palos Verdes and Peninsula High Schools. In response to these cuts, both high schools instituted a participation donation program. This program allowed us to continue our programs at the highest level and with outstanding opportunities for all students.

The Participation Donation amounts for each activity/sport/co-curricular are determined by dividing the costs associated with each activity by the number of participants/players. Costs include: transportation, entries, game officials, equipment and game attendants. These costs are reviewed annually and may be increased or decreased depending upon the number of participants. Advisor/Coaching Stipends (in-season and out-of-season) are not paid with Participation Donation funds.

BOOSTER CLUB

PVHS' fundraising organization – supplements limited state funding and meets ongoing annual costs for all academic, arts and athletic programs. Provides funding for teacher and counselor professional development/training, Library Research database subscriptions, CCC programs and expenses, field maintenance and out of season stipends for coaches and advisors. The Booster Club also funds facility upgrades such as the turf field, dance floors and athletic lockers. In addition, the Booster Club supports extracurricular programs such as Live from 205, Mock Trial and Journalism as well as the music and performing arts programs at PVHS. The PVHS Booster Club is a 501c3 non-profit organization and all donations are tax deductible. Funds are raised through an annual Membership Drive as well as the annual "Catch the Wave" event.

PTSA – Parent Teacher Student Association

PTSA is PVHS' parent organization that promotes the welfare of youth in school, at home and in the community. Programs include Disaster Preparedness, College Speakers, Reflections, Capitol Convoy, Red Ribbon Week as well as a significant Gifting Program that dedicates funds to teacher's classroom needs. An annual PTSA donation along with PTA membership fee funds all programs and gifting. The PVHS PTSA is a 501c3 non-profit organization and all donations are tax deductible.

PEF – Peninsula Education Foundation

PEF is a District wide fundraising organization which supports ALL schools in PVPUSD. PEF is a 501c3 non-profit organization and all donations are tax deductible. At the High Schools, PEF supports the CCC, Academic Counselors, classroom teaching positions, PVIT and the Chuck Miller Teacher Grants.

Uniform Donation

Helps defray the cost of uniform replacement for teams that follow a “check in and check out” process.
